Bible Readings

One or more readings from the Bible are read. At the end, the reader says:

This is the Word of the Lord

All: Thanks be to God

Canticle - The Venite

The Venite, or another canticle, may be said here.

All: O come, let us sing to the Lord;

let us heartily rejoice in the rock of our salvation.

Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving

and be glad in him with psalms.

For the Lord is a great God and a great king above all gods.

In his hand are the depths of the earth

and the heights of the mountains are his also.

The sea is his, for he made it,

and his hands have moulded the dry land.

Come, let us worship and bow down

and kneel before the Lord our Maker.

For he is our God; we are the people of his pasture

or

Lord of the Church,

All: hear our prayers, and make us one in heart and mind to serve you with joy for ever. Amen.

TIME TO REFLECT

A time of quiet reflection and private prayer may take place here.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

As our saviour taught us, so we pray:

All: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today your daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and for ever. Amen.

THE PEACE

The following, or another introduction, may be used to introduce the peace.

We are the body of Christ. In the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body. Let us then pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life. The peace of the Lord be always with you

Holy Trinity, forever one, whose nature is community; source of all sharing, in whom we love, and meet, and know our neighbour: life in all its fullness, making all things new.

All: We give you thanks and praise.

Keep us, Father, in this community of faith, the Church of your Son Jesus Christ, and help us to confess him as Lord in all we say and do.

All: Amen.

To a troubled world

All: peace from Christ.

To a searching world

All: love from Christ.

To a waiting world

All: hope from Christ.

May the Father from whom every family in earth and heaven receives its name strengthen us with his Spirit in our inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith.

All: And may the blessing of God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit be with each one of us, today and always. Amen.
